### ARTIST BIOGRAPHY

Artist, director and writer, Ken Hudson was born and raised in Toronto. He received his bachelor's degree in literature from the *University of Toronto* and pursued post-graduate study at the *Institute for the Psychological Study of the Arts, University of Florida*. It was there that he began his active study of the theatre, both acting in Shakespearean works and writing a play, *The First Lie*. Seeking more direct experience, Mr. Hudson returned to Toronto and studied physical theatre in its various forms with a range of internationally recognized artists and teachers before forming a theatrical laboratory with like-minded colleagues. Since that time he has directed and created works applying his distinct theatrical process, notably *The King #5 Henry* and *Flying Dog Show*. He resides both in Toronto and near Peterborough, Ontario, where he teaches physical theatre. Mr. Hudson is the artistic director for *Luke Arts*.
